8:15 a.m. breakfast



## We Are A House of Study

### Religious School Education

Temple B'nai Shalom is nationally-recognized for our innovative and inspirational education program for students from Pre-K through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We strive to enrich their Jewish experience and knowledge in order to strengthen their understanding of God, their identification with the Jewish people, and their participation in Reform Jewish life.



Our Pre-K through 10<sup>th</sup> grade students attend Religious School on Sunday mornings. In addition, students in grades 4 through 7 attend Hebrew School on Tuesday evenings.

Post-Confirmation students (grades 11 and 12) meet for advanced study on selected Sunday evenings. 99% of our students continue through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. TBS has had more rabbinic students at HUC-JIR than any congregation in America.

### Adult Education (L.I.F.E.)

Our programs support one of the core values of Temple B'nai Shalom by providing the opportunity for adults to explore Jewish studies, ideas, and identity. The programs are open to all adult members. Each year we select a theme for study. Adult Hebrew and B'nai Mitzvah are offered regularly.
